PROCLAMATION

WHEREAS, Minnesota ranks fifth in egg production in the nation, with an annual production of eight million cases, and

WHEREAS, Minnesota egg production accounts for more than four percent of the total cash farm income in the state amounting to sixty million dollars, and

WHEREAS, eggs are one of nature's most nearly perfect foods, and fill an important dietary requirement, combining a heavy concentration of high quality protein with relatively few calories,

NOW, THEREFORE, I, Karl F. Rolvaag, Governor of the State of Minnesota, do hereby proclaim the month of March, 1965, as

"EGG MONTH"

in Minnesota, and urge all citizens of the State to join in the observance by buying, serving to their families and enjoying the goodness of fresh eggs, served in any of their delicious forms.

IN WITNESS WHEREOF, I have hereunto set my hand and caused the Great Seal of the State of Minnesota to be affixed at the State Capitol this second day of March in the year of our Lord one thousand nine hundred and sixty-five and of the State, the one hundred seventh.
