KNOW ALL MEN BY THESE PRESENTS, That I, ROBERT W. MATTSON, Attorney General of the State of Minnesota, by virtue of the authority vested in me by statute, and particularly by authority of Minnesota Statutes 1961, Section 8.06, and upon the request of the Commissioner of Highways, do hereby constitute and appoint

RUPERT P. KENNEDY

of Edina, Minnesota, as Special Assistant Attorney General, assigned to the Department of Highways, for the period commencing March 17, 1965, and to serve at the pleasure of the Attorney General, or until this appointment shall be revoked or otherwise terminated in accordance with law; and I hereby fix the compensation of said RUPERT P. KENNEDY at the sum of Seven Thousand Two Hundred Dollars (\$7,200) per annum, to be paid from the appropriation made for that Department.

IN TESTIMONY WHEREOF, I have hereunto set my hand at St. Paul, Minnesota, this 15th day of March, 1965.






