



ORDINANCE NO. 374

AN ORDINANCE EXTENDING THE CORPORATE LIMITS OF THE CITY OF WORTHINGTON, MINNESOTA, TO INCLUDE CERTAIN PLATTED LANDS.

The City Council of the City of Worthington do Ordain:

Section 1. The territory hereinafter described, is now owned by the City of Worthington; and whereas said property is situated outside of but contiguous to, and abutting the corporate limits of the City, the City Council of said City of Worthington has determined to have such lands included within the City of Worthington, Minnesota:

Lots Two (2), Three (3), Four (4) and Five (5), County Auditor's Plat of Dune Outlets in the NE $\frac{1}{4}$ of Section 26, NW $\frac{1}{4}$ of Section 25, the SW $\frac{1}{4}$ of Section 24, and the SE $\frac{1}{4}$ of Section 23, all in Township 102 North, Range 40 West, in the County of Nobles, State of Minnesota.

Section 2. The quantity of land embraced within the foregoing description is 12.4 acres.

Section 3. Notice was duly given the public that said matter was being considered by the City Council of the City of Worthington and a hearing was duly held by the City Council of the City of Worthington, on the proposed annexation after publication of notice of hearing as required by City Charter.

Section 4. The City Council hereby determines (1) that the annexation will be to the best interests of the City of Worthington, Minnesota, and of the territory affected; (2) that the territory described herein abuts upon the City and is so conditioned as properly to be subjected to city government.

Section 5. The corporate limits of the city are hereby extended to include the property described in Section 1, and the same is hereby annexed to, and included in the City as effectually as if it had originally been a part thereof.

Section 6. The City Clerk is hereby directed to file certified copies of this ordinance with the Municipal Corporation, the County Auditor and the Secretary of State.

Section 7. This ordinance shall take effect upon its passage and publication and upon the filing of the certified copies as directed in Section 6.
