AN OPDINANCE EXTENDING THE CORPORATE LIMITS OF THE CITY OF MARSHALL TO INCLUDE UNPLATTED LAND NOT EXCEEDING TWO HUNDRED ACRES IN AREA AND CERTAIN UNINCORPORATED PLATTED LAND ABUTTING UPON THE CITY LIMITS.

The Common Council of the City of Marshall do ordain as follows:

Section 1. A petition has been filed with the Common Council of the

City of Marshall, signed by a majority of the owners in number, to-wit,

75% of such owners of the land described herein, requesting the common

Council to annex said land to the City of Marshall. The land described

in said petition is located in the Townships of take Marshall and Fairview,

Lyon County, Minnesota, including all highway and street rights-of-way on

section and quarter lines, and is described as follows:

That part of the Southeast Quarter (SEA) of Section 34, Township 112 North, Range 41 West, described as beginning at the southeast corner of sald Southeast Quarter (SE4); thence north O degrees, OI minutes and O6 seconds west along the east line of said Southeast Quarter (SE4) a distance of 2063.81 feet; thence south 75 degrees, 49 minutes and 53 seconds west a distance of 999.58 feet; thence scuthwesterly along a tangential curve concave to the southeast having a radius of 59.89 feet, delta angle of 73 degrees, 53 minutes and 54 seconds for a distance of 77.24 feet; thence south O degrees, 03 minutes and 31 seconds east, and tangent to said curve, for a distance of 1035.28 feet; thence southwesterly along a tangential curve concave to the northwest having a radius of 50.9 feet, delta angle of 89 degrees, 15 minutes and 54 seconds for a distance of 79.3 feet; thence south 69 degrees, 12 minutes and 23 seconds west, and tangent to said curve, for a distance of 1398.89 feet; thence north O degrees, OI minutes 50 seconds west 200 feet; thence south 89 degrees, 12 minutes 23 seconds west 200 feet to a point on the north-south quarter line of said Section 34; thence southerly along said quarter line 820.06 feet more or less to the southwest corner of the Southeast Quarter (SE4) of said Section 34, which is also the northwest corner of the Northeast Quarter (NE&) of Section 3, Township III North, Range 41 West; thence southerly along the north-south quarter line of said Section 3, to the west sixteenth corner of the said Northeast Quarter (NE#) of said Section 3; thence easterly along the east-west sixteenth line of said Northeast Quarter (NEX) of said Section 3, to a point on the east section line of said Section 3; thence northerly along sald section line to the northeast corner of the Northeast Quarter INEA) of said Section 3, which is also the southeast corner of the Southeast Quarter (SE4) of Section 34, Township 112 North, Range 41 West and point of beginning, containing 148.40 acres, more or less.

Said petition has also been filed with the Town Board of the Townships of Lake Marshall and Fairview, with the County Board of the County of Lyon and with the Municipal Commission of the State of Minnesota and more than thirty 1301 days have elapsed since said petition was filed with said Town

Boards and County Board and no objections to annexation of the above descrobed land have been filed by sold Foun Boards or County Board.

Section 2. The Common Council of the City of Morshall does hereby determine that the lands described in section I hereof abut upon the present territorial limits of the City of Marshall, are so conditioned as to be properly subjected to municipal government, and the annexation of said lands will be in the best interests of the City of Marshall and of the lands offected.

Section 3. Therefore, the lands described in Section I above are hereby annoxed, added to and made a part of the City of Marchall, Minaesota, as effectually as if they had originally been a part thereof.

Section 6. This Ordinance chall take effect and be in force from and after its official publication and from and after the filing of a certified copy hereof with the Minnesote Municipal Commission, the County Auditor and the Secretary of State.
