WHEREAS, April 14, 1965, marks the 75th anniversary of the founding of the Inter-American System, and

WHEREAS, Pan American Day, which has been celebrated since 1930, is a symbol of the unity, friendship, and solidarity which characterizes the American republics, and

WHEREAS, the Alliance for Progress, the most ambitious program of economic and social development ever known on the Continent, was established by the Organization of American States to fulfill the aspirations of our peoples, and

WHEREAS, President Johnson has designated April 14 as Pan American Day and April 18 - 24 as Pan American Week,

NOW, THEREFORE, I, Karl F. Rolvaag, Governor of the State of Minnesota, do hereby proclaim April 14, 1965, as


"PAN AMERICAN DAY"




