PROCLAMATION

WHEREAS, the Student Minnesota Education Association (which has almost 5,000 members in Minnesota colleges) and the Future Teachers of America of Minnesota (which has almost 5,500 members in Minnesota high schools) serve to instill in all who are preparing for a teaching career a deep sense of professionalism, and

WHEREAS, in this way, new teachers are made aware from the outset that the task of training young minds imposes on them a great and important responsibility, and

WHEREAS, this year, one week is to be set aside during April, which is observed as TEACHING CAREER MONTH, in recognition of the Student Minnesota Education Association and the Future Teachers of America of Minnesota.

NOW, THEREFORE, I, Karl F. Rolvaag, Governor of the State of Minnesota, do hereby designate April 13 - 17, 1965, as

"STUDENT EDUCATION WEEK"

In Minnesota, and congratulate the Minnesota college and high school students who are members of the Student Minnesota Education Association and the Future Teachers of America of Minnesota on having recognized the advantages of belonging to professional organizations, and urge all of our citizens to make "Student Education Week" an occasion for paying tribute to those young people who are preparing for careers of vital service.
