Writ of election providing for the filling of a vacancy in the office of State Senator from the Twenty-second Senatorial District at a special election to be held on May 4th, 1965, and providing for nomination of candidates for said vacancy at a special primary election to be held on April 20th 1965.

To the people of the State of Minnesota and particularly of the Twenty-second Senatorial District of said state; To the Secretary of State of the State of Minnesota; To the County Auditors of the Counties of Lac qui Parle, Chippewa, and Yellow Medicine in said state; to all election officers in the Twenty-second Senatorial District, and all of the several election districts therein; and To All Others whom it may concern:


WHEREAS a vacancy now exists in the office of State Senator from the Twenty-second Senatorial District caused by the death of Honorable Fay George Child; and

WHEREAS the State Legislature is now in session and the person elected to fill said vacancy will have occasion to take office and exercise the functions thereof immediately after his election;


NOW, THEREFORE, I, KARL F. ROLVAAG, AS GOVERNOR OF THE STATE OF MINNESOTA, acting under the authority and direction of Section 17 of Article IV of the Minnesota Constitution and the statutes in such case made and provided, do hereby direct that said vacancy be filled at a special election to be held in said

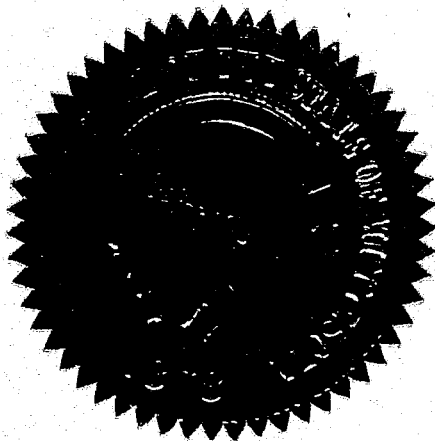
district on Tuesday, the 4th day of May, 1965, and that candidates for said office be nominated at a special primary election to be held in said district on Tuesday, the 20th day of April, 1965; that affidavits of candidacy for nomination at said primary may be filed on and between the 7th day of April, 1965 and the 13th day of April, 5:00 P.M., 1965, both dates inclusive; that notices of said primary election and the said election thereafter be given, posted, and published as prescribed by law; and that the nomination and election of candidates and the conduct of said elections be had, and all things pertaining thereto be done, as provided in Minnesota Statutes, Sections 203.44 to 203.56, and other applicable provisions of law.

IN WITNESS WHEREOF I have hereunto set my hand and caused the great seal of the State of Minnesota to be hereunto affixed at the Capitol in the City of Saint Paul, Minnesota, this 6th day of April A.D., 1965.
