ORDINANCE NO. 257

BEING AN ORDINANCE EXTENDING THE CORPORATE LIMIT OF THE CITY OF ORTONVILLE, MINNESOTA, TO INCLUDE CERTAIN PROPERTY IN HILLTOP ADDITION.

The City Council of the City of Ortonville, Minnesota, does ordain:

Section 1. Territory Annexed. Positions having been duly filled with the City Council of the City of Ortonville, Minnesota, by the Tri-County Land Co. by Archie A. Sealoy, President and Eugene O'Neill, Secretary, Stanley W. Hall and Ross Hall, Earl Cartwright and Mrs. Earl Cartwright, Elmer J. Crague and Gretchen I. Crague, A. G. Kroon, J. J. Sutton, C. B. Knorhor and Gladys R. Knorhor, owners of a certain tract of land abutting on the corporate limits of the said City, as herein described, the corporate limits of the City of Ortonville, Minnesota, are hereby extended to include that certain tract of land described as follows:

Tract of Land located in the S^{1/2} of the S^{1/4} of Section 9, Township 121 north, Range 46 West. Beginning at the S.E. corner of said Section 9, Township 121 north, Range 46 West, thence in a northerly direction along the section line for a distance of 1715.6', thence west with a delta angle of 90°00' for a distance of 1528.6', thence south with a delta angle of 90°00' for a distance of 1705.6', thence east for a distance of 1520.6' to the point of beginning.

Section 2. Effective Date. This Ordinance shall take effect thirty (30) days after its publication.
