
Dear Ms. Mitchell:

ORDINANCE NO. 257

BEING AN ORDINANCE EXTENDING THE CORPORATE LIMITS OF THE CITY OF OTTENVILLE, MINNESOTA, TO INCLUDE CERTAIN PROPERTY IN HILLOP ADDITION.

The City Council of the City of Ottenville, Minnesota, does ordain:

Section 1. Territory Annexed. Petitions having been duly filed with the City Council of the City of Ottenville, Minnesota, by the Tri-County Land Co. by Archie A. Scaloy, President and Eugene O'Neill, Secretary, Stanley H. Hall and Ross Hall, Earl Cartwright and Mrs. Earl Cartwright, Elmer J. Crooge and Gretchen I. Crooge, A. G. Bruno, J. J. Sutton, C. E. Warrener and Gladys R. Warrener, owners of a certain tract of land abutting on the corporate limits of the said City, as herein described, the corporate limits of the City of Ottenville, Minnesota, are hereby extended so include that certain tract of land described as follows:

Tract of land located in the E $\frac{1}{2}$ of the S $\frac{1}{2}$ of Section 9, Township 121 north, Range 46 West. Beginning at the S.E. corner of said Section 9, Township 121 north, Range 46 West, thence in a northerly direction along the section line for a distance of 1713.6', thence west with a delta angle of 90°00' for a distance of 1328.6', thence south with a delta angle of 90°00' for a distance of 1705.6', thence east for a distance of 1328.6' to the point of beginning.

Section 2. Effective Date. This Ordinance shall take effect thirty (30) days after its publication.
