

**ORDINANCE EXTENDING THE CORPORATE LIMITS OF THE VILLAGE OF MILACA TO INCLUDE CERTAIN UNPLATTED LAND NOT EXCEEDING 200 ACRES.**

WHEREAS, a certain petition signed by all of the owners of land proposed to be annexed requesting annexation of the territory described below was duly presented to the Council on the 24th day of February, 1965 a copy of which petition had theretofore been served upon Milaca Township, the County of Mille Lacs, and upon Minnesota Municipal Commission; and

WHEREAS more than thirty (30) days has elapsed since the presentation of said petition to the Village Council and that neither the Town Board of Milaca Township or the County Board of Mille Lacs County or the governing body of any municipality has submitted written objections to the annexation to either the Minnesota Municipal Commission or to the Village Council of the Village of Milaca

The Council of the Village of Milaca ordains:

Section 1. Declaration. It is hereby determined that the territory described below abuts upon the Village of Milaca, is so conditioned as properly to be subjected to village government, and that the proposed annexation is in the best interests of the Village of Milaca and of said territory involved

Section 2. Territory Annexed. The corporate limits of the village are hereby extended to include the territory described as follows:

Commencing at the Southwest Corner of Section Twenty-four, Township Thirty-eight North, Range Twenty-seven West thence North 89°40' East along the South Section Line a distance of 697.6 feet to the point of beginning, thence North 89°40' East along the same line a distance of 375.0 feet, thence North 1°46' West a distance of 710.0 feet, thence South 89°40' West a distance of 375.0 feet, thence South 1°46' East a distance of 710.0 feet to the point of beginning. Less 10.0 foot Street Right of Way along South boundary; containing approximately 6.0 Acres; and

Beginning at the Southwest Corner of Section 24, Township 38N., Range 27W.; thence Northerly along the Section line a distance of 210.0 feet; thence Easterly parallel to the South Section line a distance of 190.0 feet; thence Southerly parallel to the West Section line a distance of 210.0 feet; thence Westerly along the Section line a distance of 190.0 feet to the point of beginning, less 10.0 foot right of way along the South Section line, all of said tract being in the SW¼ of SW¼ of Section 24, Twp. 38N., Rge 27W. and containing approximately .91 of an acre; and

Commencing at the Southwest corner of Section 24, Township 38N., Range 27W.; thence Northerly along the section line a distance of 210.0 feet, thence Easterly parallel to the South section line a distance of 190 feet to point of beginning, thence Southerly parallel to the West Section line a distance of 50 feet, thence Easterly parallel to the South Section line a distance of 100 feet, thence southerly parallel to the West Section line a distance of 160 feet to the South Section line, thence Easterly on and along the South Section line a distance of 134.0 feet, thence Northerly parallel to the West Section line a distance of 210 feet, thence Westerly parallel to the South Section line a distance of 234 feet to point of beginning, less 10.0 foot right of way along South Section line, containing approximately .76 acres ; and

Beginning at the Southwest corner of Section 24, Township 38N., Range 27W., thence easterly 190 feet to a point, being the point of beginning of the tract herein conveyed; thence Northerly parallel to the west sec. line 160 feet; thence easterly parallel to the south section line a distance of 100 feet; thence Southerly parallel to the West Section line a distance of 160 feet; thence Westerly along So. Section line a distance of 100 feet to the point of beginning, less 10.0 foot right of way along South Section line; all of said tract being in the SW $\frac{1}{4}$  of SW $\frac{1}{4}$  of Sec. 24, Twp. 38N., Rge 27W., Mille Lacs County, Minnesota and containing approximately .37 of an acre.

Section 3. Filing. The Village Clerk is hereby directed to file certified copies of this ordinance in the office of the Secretary of State, and the office of the County Auditor of Mille Lacs County, and the office of Town Clerk of Milaca Township, and with the Secretary of Minnesota Municipal Commission, State Capitol, St. Paul 1, Minnesota

Section 4. Effective Date of Annexation. Annexation shall be completed from and after the date when certified copies of this ordinance have been filed as directed in Section 3.
