



ORDINANCE NO. 436

An ordinance extending the corporate limits of the City of Willmar, a Municipal Corporation of the State of Minnesota.

BE IT ORDAINED by the City Council of the City of Willmar, a Municipal Corporation, as follows:

WHEREAS, the City of Willmar, a Municipal Corporation, of the State of Minnesota, is the fee title owner of the lands hereinafter described, and whereas it is proposed to annex said lands to the said City of Willmar,

NOW THEREFORE, The City Council of the City of Willmar hereby determines, ordains and declares as follows:

1. That the lands to be annexed hereby are described as follows:

Tract A. All that part of Robbins Island located in the Northwest Quarter of Section Eleven (11), Township One Hundred Nineteen (119) North, Range Thirty-five (35) West, Kandiyohi County, Minnesota, lying in Willmar Lake and Foot Lake, Northerly of the East-West quarter line of said Section Eleven (11).

Tract B. All that part of Sections Sixteen (16) and Seventeen (17) of Township One Hundred Nineteen (119), Range Thirty-five (35), Kandiyohi County, Minnesota, described by metes and bounds as follows, to-wit:

Commencing at a point on the East-West quarter line of said Section Seventeen (17) which said point is 182.17 feet West of the East line of said Section Seventeen (17) and which point shall be the point of beginning; thence Northerly in a straight line parallel to the East line of said Section Seventeen (17) to the North line of the Southeast Quarter of the Northeast Quarter ($SE\frac{1}{4}$ of $NE\frac{1}{4}$) of said Section Seventeen (17); thence West on the North line of the Southeast Quarter of the Northeast Quarter ($SE\frac{1}{4}$ of $NE\frac{1}{4}$) of said Section Seventeen (17) continuing along the North line of the Southwest Quarter of the Northeast Quarter ($SW\frac{1}{4}$ of $NE\frac{1}{4}$) of said Section Seventeen (17) to the North-South Quarter line of said Section Seventeen (17); thence Southerly along the said North-South Quarter line to the center of said Section Seventeen (17); thence Westerly along the East-West quarter line of said Section Seventeen (17) to the Northwest corner of the Northeast Quarter of the Southwest Quarter ($NE\frac{1}{4}$ of $SW\frac{1}{4}$) of said Section Seventeen (17); thence

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Southerly along the West line of the Northeast Quarter of the Southwest Quarter of said Section Seventeen (17) to the Southwest corner of the Northeast Quarter of the Southwest Quarter ($NE\frac{1}{4}$ of $SW\frac{1}{4}$) of said Section Seventeen (17); thence Easterly along the South line of the Northeast Quarter of the Southwest Quarter ($NE\frac{1}{4}$ of $SW\frac{1}{4}$) of said Section Seventeen (17) to the North-South quarter line of said Section Seventeen (17); thence Northerly along said North-South quarter line of said Section Seventeen (17) a distance of 215 feet to a point; thence Easterly along a line parallel to the South line of said Section Seventeen (17) a distance of 565 feet to a point; thence Southerly along a line parallel to the North-South quarter line of said Section Seventeen (17) a distance of 215 feet to a point; thence Easterly along a line parallel to the South line of said Section Seventeen (17) to the Southwest corner of the Northeast Quarter of the Southeast Quarter ($NE\frac{1}{4}$ of $SE\frac{1}{4}$) of said Section Seventeen (17); thence South along the West line of the Southeast Quarter of the Southeast Quarter ($SE\frac{1}{4}$ of $SE\frac{1}{4}$) of said Section Seventeen (17) to the South line of said Section Seventeen (17); thence East along the said South line of said Section Seventeen (17) continuing along the South line of said Section Sixteen (16) to the Southeast corner of the Southwest Quarter of the Southwest Quarter ($SW\frac{1}{4}$ of $SW\frac{1}{4}$) of said Section Sixteen (16); thence Northerly along the East line of the Southwest Quarter of the Southwest Quarter ($SW\frac{1}{4}$ of $SW\frac{1}{4}$) of said Section Sixteen (16) to the Northeast corner of said Southwest Quarter of the Southwest Quarter ($SW\frac{1}{4}$ of $SW\frac{1}{4}$) of said Section Sixteen (16); thence Westerly along the North line of the Southwest Quarter of the Southwest Quarter ($SW\frac{1}{4}$ of $SW\frac{1}{4}$) of said Section Sixteen (16) to a point on said North line which said point is 640 feet Easterly of the Northwest corner of the Southwest Quarter of the Southwest Quarter ($SW\frac{1}{4}$ of $SW\frac{1}{4}$) of said Section Sixteen (16); thence Northwesterly along a straight line to a point on a line running North and South and parallel with the East line of said Section Seventeen (17) distant 182.17 feet Westerly of said East line of said Section Seventeen (17); thence Northerly 1,824.35 feet to the point of beginning.

2. That the annexation will be to the best interest of the City of Willmar, Minnesota, and of the territory affected.

3. That the property above described abutts upon the City, and is so conditioned as probably to be subject to the City Government and is owned by the said City of Willmar.
4. That said property is hereby annexed and included within the City of Willmar, Minnesota, as effectually as if it had originally been a part hereof.
5. Effective date. This Ordinance shall be final and shall take effect and be in full force from and after filing a certified copy hereof with the Minnesota Municipal Commission, The County Auditor of the County of Kandiyohi, Minnesota, the Town Clerk of the Township of Willmar, and the Secretary of State of Minnesota, and from and after its passage and publication.

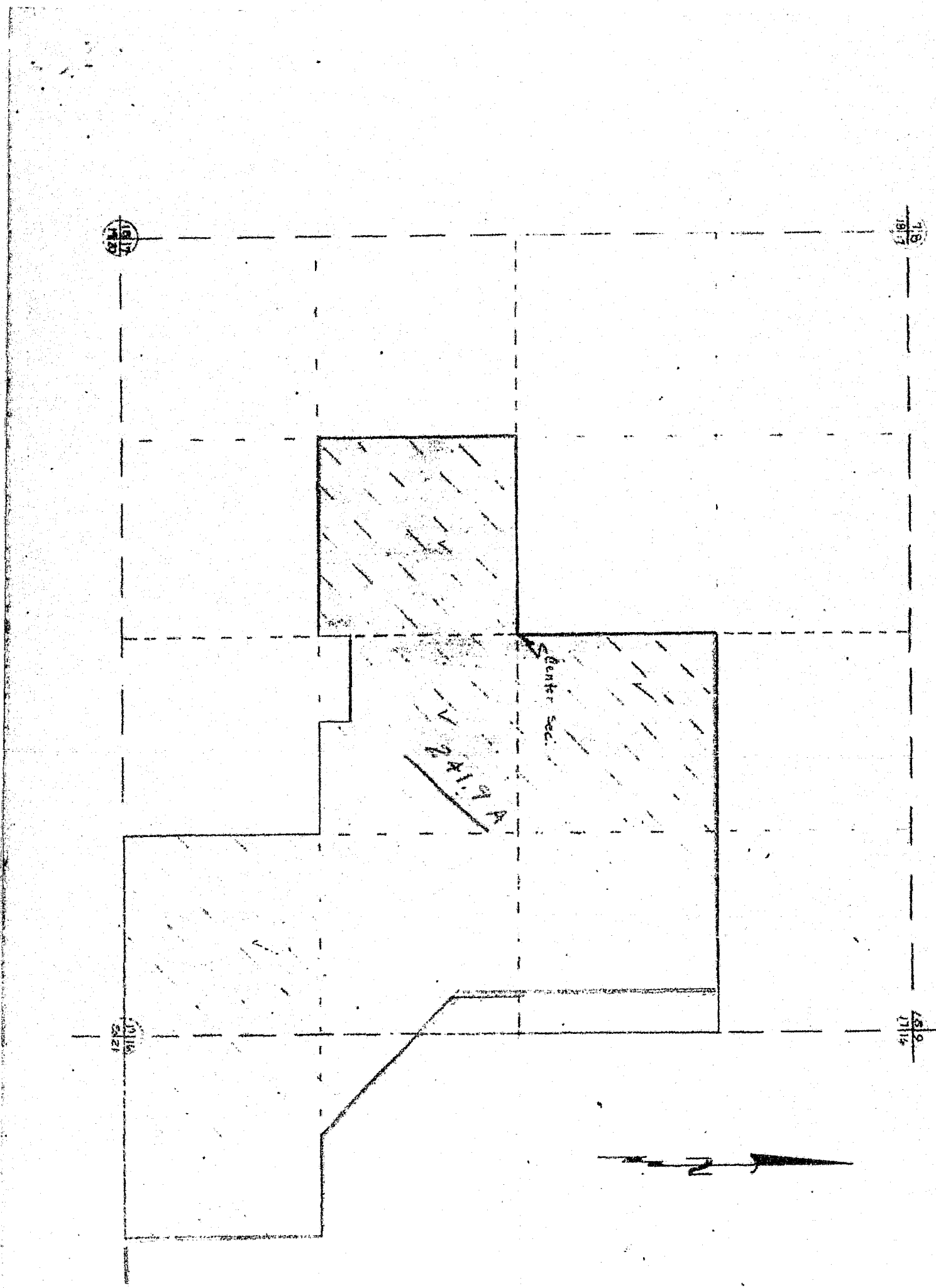

A triangular parcel of land in the NW 1/4 of the SW 1/4 described as follows:

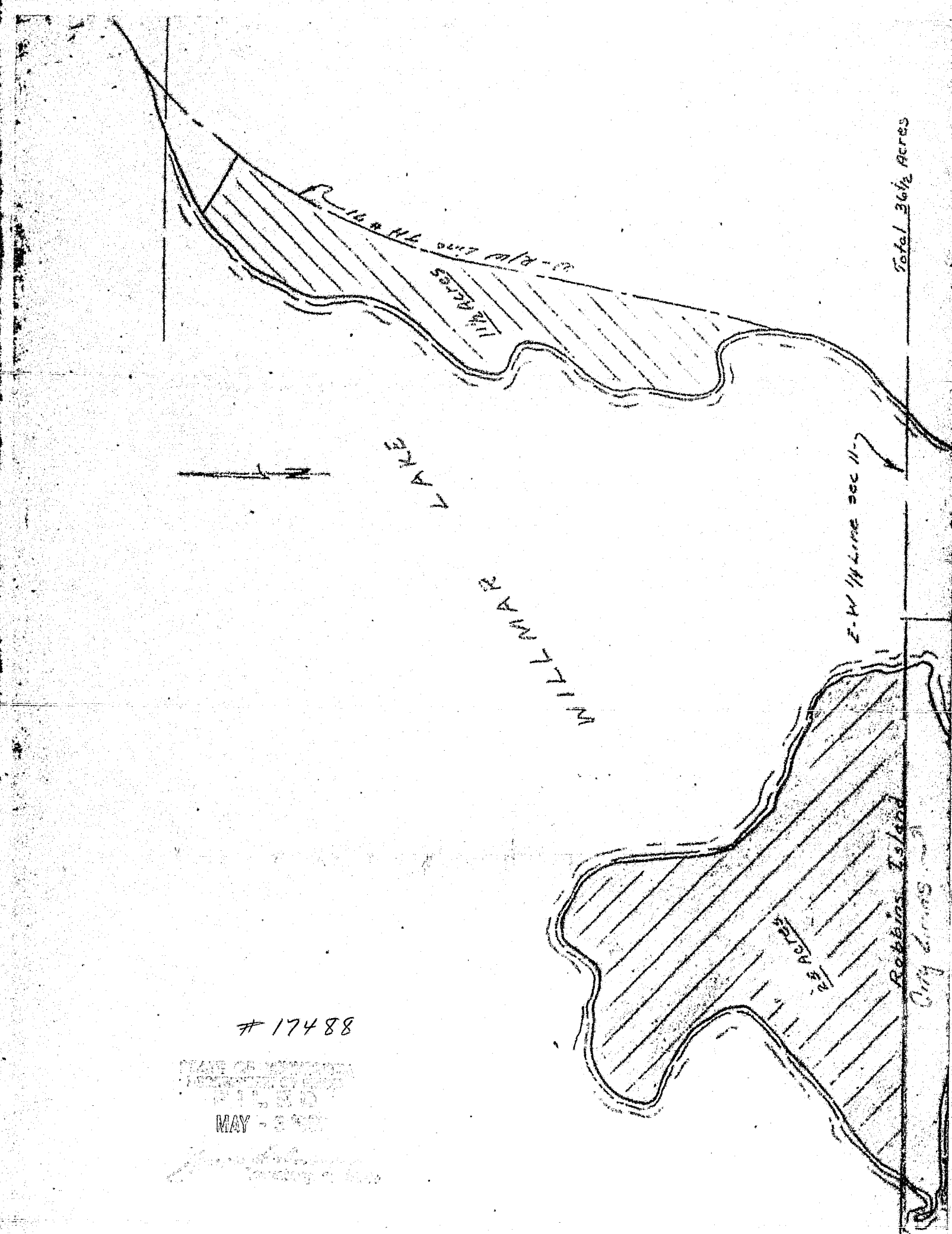

Beginning at a point on the N. line of the SW 1/4 of Sec. 11, T119N, R35W, where it intersects the W. boundary line of Robbins Island at Foot Lake; thence northeasterly along the shore of Foot Lake to a point on the North boundary of Robbins Island where Willmar Lake and Foot Lake coincide; thence southeasterly along the shore of Willmar Lake to its intersection with the E-W 1/4 line to the point of beginning.
