

ORDINANCE NO. 375

AN ORDINANCE EXTENDING THE CORPORATE LIMITS OF THE CITY OF WORTHINGTON, MINNESOTA, TO INCLUDE CERTAIN UNPLATTED LANDS.

The City Council of the City of Worthington do Ordain:

Section 1. A petition has been filed with the City Council of the City of Worthington, Minnesota, signed by all of the owners in number of the following described real estate, to have such land included within the City of Worthington, Minnesota:

That part of the Southeast Quarter (SE $\frac{1}{4}$ ) of Section 27, and the Southwest Quarter (SW $\frac{1}{4}$ ) of Section 26, all in Township 102 North, Range 40, West of the 5th Principal Meridian, Nobles County, Minnesota, described as follows: Beginning at a point 70 feet East of the Southeast corner of Lot 22 in Block 9 of Auditor's Plat of Blocks 9 and 11, Ludlow Acres in Part of Government Lot 2, Section 27, T. 102 N., R. 40 W., Nobles County, Minnesota, said point of beginning being on the section line between said Sections 26 and 27; thence South 0° 18' W 70.0 feet along said section line; thence South 89° 37' E 38.0 feet; thence S 0° 18' W 125.0 feet; thence N 89° 37' W 579.7 feet and S 60° 25' W 348.7 feet along the South line of Lots 1 to 11, both inclusive in Block 11 of said Ludlow Acres; thence N 89° 21' W 70.0 feet; thence S 8° 39' W 219.8 feet; thence S 89° 21' E 70.0 feet; thence N 60° 25' E 222.64 feet to the point of curvature of a curve having a radius of 25 feet; thence to the right along said curve 52.45 feet to the point of tangency; thence S 0° 37' W 4.15 feet; thence S 89° 37' E 242.0 feet; thence N 80° 47' E 162.4 feet; thence S 89° 37' E 320.0 feet; thence N 0° 18' E 477.5 feet; thence N 89° 37' W 100.0 feet to the point of beginning, enclosing 6.73 acres.

Section 2. The quantity of Land embraced within the foregoing description, and bounded and described is 6.73 acres.

Section 3. Notice was duly given the Board of Commissioners for Nobles County and the Board of Commissioners for Worthington Township on March 29, 1965, that said matter was being considered by the City Council of the City of Worthington and a hearing was duly held by the City Council of the City of Worthington, on the proposed annexation after publication of notice of hearing as required by City Charter.

Section 4. The City Council hereby determines (1) that the annexation will be to the best interests of the City of Worthington, Minnesota, and of the territory affected; (2) that the territory described herein abuts upon the City and is so conditioned as properly to be subjected to City government.

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Section 5. The corporate limits of the city are hereby extended to include the property described in Section 1, and the same is hereby annexed to, and included in the City as effectually as if it had originally been a part thereof.

Section 6. The City Clerk is hereby directed to file certified copies of this ordinance with the Minnesota Municipal Corporation, the County Auditor and the Secretary of State.

Section 7. This ordinance shall take effect upon its passage and publication and upon the filing of the certified copies as directed in Section 6.
