P R O C L A M A T I O N

WHEREAS, the County of Dakota has been stricken and is continuing to be stricken by floods and other actions of the elements, and

WHEREAS, Laws 1965, Chapter 206 has been enacted into law to provide certain emergency powers to the City of South St. Paul in the County of Dakota, and

WHEREAS, the emergency powers provided herein are essential to prevent the causes of the above disaster, the spread of the disaster, and to alleviate the damages caused thereby,

NOW, THEREFORE, I, Karl F. Rolvaag, Governor of the State of Minnesota, do hereby proclaim the County of Dakota as a disaster area within the purview of Laws 1965, Chapter 206.

IN WITNESS WHEREOF, I have hereunto set my hand and caused the Great Seal of the State of Minnesota to be affixed at the State Capitol this nineteenth day of April, 1965.
