PROCLAMATION

- WHEREAS, the people of the State of Minnesota hold members of the Armed Forces in high esteem, and
- WHEREAS, we recognize that without the dedication and sacrifices of the members of our Armed Forces there would be no Free World as we know it today, and
- WHEREAS, the men and women who wear the uniforms of the Armed Forces of our nation have earned the gratitude of all people, and
- WHEREAS, we the citizens of the State of Minnesota wish to pay tribute to the members of the Armed Forces, and
- WHEREAS, the third week in May has been set aside as Armed Forces Week in these United States,
- NOW, THEREFORE, I, Karl F. Rolvang, Governor of the State of Minnesota, do hereby proclaim May 10 through May 16, 1965, as

"ARMED FORCES WEEK"

in Minnesota, and urge the citizens of Minnesota to join us in the observance of Armed Forces Week and in so doing pay special tribute to the men and women of the Armed Services who stand ready around the world as an essential element of this nation's Power For Peace.
