PROCLAMATION

WHEREAS, the American Foot Health Foundation has reported that two out of three children face the future on unfit feet, and

WHEREAS, through medical progress the journey of life has been lengthened and eighty-five percent of our senior citizens have foot disorders, and

WHEREAS, it is the common responsibility of every citizen of the State of Minnesota to contribute to greater knowledge and understanding of the vital necessity of sound foot health in the foundation of the general health and welfare of our nation,

NOW, THEREFORE, I, Karl F. Rolvaag, Governor of the State of Minnesota, do hereby proclaim the period of May 14 through May 21, 1965, as

"FOOT HEALTH WEEK"

in Minnesota, and urge that the observance of this week be signalized by the participation of all residents, particularly parents, doctors, teachers, nurses, health and welfare groups and channels of communication, in this week's program, sponsored by the American Foot Health Foundation, through the Minnesota Podiatry Association in disseminating educational information to create a greater awareness of proper foot health habits in every man, woman and child.
