## PROCLAMATION

WHEREAS, the Professional Golfers' Association of America will sponsor the fourteenth annual NATIONAL GOLF DAY on Monday, May 31, 1965, and

WHEREAS, during the last thirteen years, some \$1,000,000.00 has been raised from NATIONAL GOLF DAY for United Service Organizations, the American Red Cross, Caddie Scholarship Funds, the U. S. Blind Golfers Association, the National Amputee Golf Association, the Jacobs War Memorial Fund, Golf Facilities at Veterans' Hospitals and Military Installations, Turf Research and Education, Golf Professional Education, financial assistance to those in straitened circumstances who have devoted their lives to Golf, and

WHEREAS, this day in 1965 will offer all the golfers of America an opportunity to again assist many of these worthy charities and projects, as well as an opportunity to compete against the PGA Champion and the USGA Open Champion.

NOW, THEREFORE, I, Karl F. Solvay, Governor of the State of Minnesota, do hereby proclaim Monday, May 31, 1965, as

### "GOLF DAY"

in the State of Minnesota and urge all the citizens of our state to cooperate in this worthwhile venture by playing a round of golf on NATIONAL GOLF DAY, thereby contributing to the many deserving charities and projects associated with this great game.
