AN ORDINANCE EXTENDING THE CORPORATE  
LIMITS OF THE CITY OF MANKATO, MINNE-  
SOTA, BY ANNEXING TO SAID CITY OF  
MANKATO PROPERTY ABUTTING ON THE CITY  
AND OWNED BY THE CITY OF MANKATO, PUR-  
SUANT TO M.S.A. 414.03.

The City of Mankato, Minnesota does ordain:

Section 1.

The following described real estate situated in Blue Earth County, Minnesota, is owned by the City of Mankato and it is the desire of said City of Mankato to annex said real estate to the City of Mankato, to-wit:

TRACT "A": U. S. Lot 8 and that part of U. S. Lot 9 situate northerly of the right of way of Chicago and Northwestern Railway, all in Section 14, Township 108, Range 27, subject to an easement for travel 24 feet in width on said Lot 9 adjoining the northerly side of said railway right of way and extending from the west line of said Lot 9 easterly along said right of way for 750 ft.

Subject to a reservation to the State of Minnesota in trust for the taxing districts concerned of all minerals and mineral rights as provided by law in and to the property above described.

Subject also to an easement for travel on Tract "A" above described as specifically reserved in the above description of said tract.

TRACT "D": All of Blocks 1 and 6 and all that portion of Block 7 northerly of the right of way of Chicago and Northwestern Railway, all of Riverside Park Addition to the City of Mankato, Minnesota, according to the plat thereof on file and of record in the office of the Register of Deeds of said County, subject to an easement for travel 24 feet in width across said Block 7 adjoining the northerly side of said railway right of way.

Subject to an easement for travel on Tract "D" above described as specifically reserved in the above description of said tract.

Section 2.

The quantity of land embraced within the foregoing description is unplatted and does not exceed 200 acres and is not within the corporate limits of any city or village and is contiguous to and abutting upon a portion of the westerly boundary of the City of Mankato, Minnesota, an incorporated city, having a population of not less than 10,000 nor more than 30,000, pursuant to the last census.

Section 3.

The City Council of Mankato, Minnesota hereby determines that the annexation of the above described property will be to the best interests of the municipality and of the land affected and that the above described tract and parcel of land is so conditioned as properly to be subjected to city government and is hereby annexed to and declared to be an addition to the City of Mankato, as effectually as if it had originally been a part thereof and the corporate limits of the City of Mankato, Minnesota are hereby extended to include said property.

The City Clerk is hereby directed to file certified copies of this ordinance with the Minnesota Municipal Commission, the County Auditor, and the Secretary of State, and this ordinance takes effect ten (10) days after its passage and publication and upon the filing of certified copies, as herein described.
