ORDINANCE NO. 173
AN ORDINANCE RELATING TO
THE ANNEXATION OF AND
ANNEXING CERTAIN LANDS
TO THE CITY OF REDWOOD
FALLS

THE CITY OF REDWOOD FALLS
DOES ORDAIN AS FOLLOWS:

1. That it is hereby found and de-
clared:

(a) That petitions have heretofore
been filed in the Office of the Red-
wood Falls City Clerk requesting the
annexation of the tracts of real estate
described in Section 2 of this Ord-
inance to the City of Redwood Falls.

(b) That more than thirty days
prior hereto copies of said petition
for annexation were filed with the
Minnesota Municipal Commission,
the Town of Honner, and the County
of Redwood, and that no objections
to the annexation of said lands to
the City of Redwood Falls have been
received by the City of Redwood Falls
from any of the above-named Minne-
sota Municipal Commission, Town of
Honner, and County of Redwood.

(c) That the hereinafter described
lands abut on the City of Redwood
Falls; that said lands are not in-
cluded in any other municipality;
that the petitions for annexation of
said lands have been signed by all
of the owners thereof; and that said
lands are unplatted and do not ex-
ceed two hundred acres in area.

(d) That the said lands are suit-
ably conditioned for municipal gov-
ernment and that the annexation of
said lands to the City of Redwood
Falls will be to the best interest of
the City of Redwood Falls, and the
territory affected.

2. That the following described
real estate lying and being in the
Town of Honner, County of Red-
wood, State of Minnesota, is hereby
annexed to the City of Redwood
Falls:

(1) Lot Number Nine (9) of Auditor's
Subdivision Number One (1) of
Section Number Thirty One (31),
Township Number One Hundred
Thirteen (113) North, Range
Number Thirty Five (35) West,
consisting of 4.85 acres more or
less, and,

(2) Lots Numbered Ten (10), Twelve
(12), and Thirteen (13) of Audi-
tor's Subdivision Number One
(1) of Section Number Thirty
One (31), in Township Number
One Hundred Thirteen (113)
North, of Range Number Thirty
Five (35) West of the 5th P. M.,
and that part of Lot Number
Eleven (11) of said Auditor's
Subdivision described as: Begin-
ning at a point on the East line
of said Section Number Thirty
One (31) a distance of Four Hun-
dred Ninety Seven and Four
Tenths (497.4) feet North of the
East Quarter corner of said Sec-
tion; thence running West Six
Hundred Seventy Four (674) feet
to the Southeast Corner of said
Lot Number Ten (10); thence
running North Six Hundred Sixty
(660) feet to the Northeast Cor-
ner of said Lot Number Ten (10);
thence running East Six Hundred
Seventy Five (675) feet to a point
on the East line of said Section
Number Thirty One (31); thence
running South on the East line
of said Section a distance of Six
Hundred Sixty (660) feet to the
point of beginning; said tract
containing, in all, 36.82 acres,
more or less.

3. That this Ordinance shall be in
full force and effect from and after
the 6th day of May, 1965.




