## ORDINANCE NO. 3/

AN ORDINANCE EXTENDING THE CORPORATE LIMITS OF THE VILLAGE OF WOLVERTON, MINESOTA, TO INCLUDE CERTAIN UNINCORPORATED UNPLATTED LAND NOT EXCEEDING 200 ACRES IN AREA ABUTTING UPON THE VILLAGE LIMITS.

WHEREAS, A certain petition dated the 26th day of March, 1965, requesting annexation of the territory hereinafter described was duly presented to the council on the 1st day of April, 1965.

AND WHEREAS, The quantity of land embraced within the area described in the petition and bounded as described is 27.40 acres of unplatted land, no part of which is included within the limits of an incorporated city, village or borough.

AND WHEREAS. The petition was signed by all of the owners of said tract of land proposed to be annexed.

AND WHEREAS, The said petition was duly filed with the Town Board of the Township of Wolverton, Wilkin County, Minnesota, on April 1, 1965, and the County Board of Wilkin County, Minnesota, on March 30, 1965, and the Minnesota Municipal Commission on April 5, 1965.

AND WHEREAS, Said tract of land proposed to be annexed does not abut on the boundaries of any municipality except the Village of Wolverton.

AND WHEREAS, More than Thirty (30) days have expired since the filing of said petitions with the said Torn Board of Wolverton Township, the said County Board of Wilkin County and the said Minnesota Municipal Commission, and no objections to said proposed annexation have been received or filed by anyone.

AND WHERMAS, The land described in the petition abuts upon the village limits of the Village of Wolverton, Minnesota, at the western boundary thereof.

NOT THEMPVER, The Council of the Village of Wolverton, Minnesota, ordains:

Section 1—The Village Council hereby finds and determines that the annexation will be in the best interests of the Village of Wolverton and the territory affected; that the territory described herein abuts upon the village limits of the Village of Wolverton at its western boundary thereof and is about to become urban or suburban in character and that none of said territory is now included within the limits of any city, village or borough and does not abut upon the limits of any city, village or borough, except the Village of Wolverton, Minnesota.

Section 2-That the corporate limits of the Village of Wolverton, Minnesota, are hereby extended to include the land proposed to be annexed in said potition and the same is hereby annexed to and included within the Village of Wolverton, Minnesota, as effectually as if it had originally been a part thereof, which said land is located in the County of Wilkin, State of Minnesota, and is described as follows, to-wit:

Government Lot Three (3) of Section Twenty-nine (29), Township One Kundred Thirty-six (136) North, of Range Forty-eight (48) West, of the 5th Principal Meridian.

Section 3-The Village Clerk is horeby directed to file cortified copies of this Ordinance with the Minnewota Municipal Commission, the Secretary of the State of Minnesota and the County Auditor of Wilkin County, Minnesota.

Section 4-Effective date. This ordinance takes effect upon its passage and publication and the filing of the certified copies as directed in Section 5.
