ORDINANCE NO. 35-16

AN ORDINANCE ANNEXING PROPERTY TO THE VILLAGE OF  
PRIOR LAKE, MINNESOTA

WHEREAS, Emmett Zweber, being the sole owner of the following described property, lying in Scott County, Minnesota:

Starting at the Southeast corner of Government Lot 2, Section 2, Township 114, Range 22, Scott County, Minnesota; thence North along the East Line of said Government Lot 2, 391.5 feet to the point of beginning; thence West 150 feet; thence North 290.5 feet to the South line of Pleasant Avenue; thence East 150 feet along the South line of Pleasant Avenue; thence South 290.5 feet to the point of beginning.

has petitioned the Village Council of the Village of Prior Lake, Minnesota, to have the above described land which lies outside the Village of Prior Lake, Minnesota, annexed to the Village of Prior Lake, Minnesota; and

WHEREAS, the Village Council deems it advisable and in the public interest that said property be so annexed; and

WHEREAS, copies of the petition for the annexation of said property have been filed with the Municipal Commission, the County Board of Scott County, and the Town Board of Spring Lake Township; and

be and the same is hereby annexed to the Village of Prior Lake, Minnesota, and  
said property is hereby declared to be an addition to said Village.

Upon the date of execution of this Ordinance, such property shall become  
a part of said Village as effectively as if it had been originally a part thereof.

and publication and after filing as hereinafter set forth. The Village Clerk

of the Municipal Commission, State of Minnesota, and in the Office of the  
Secretary of State of the State of Minnesota.





AN ORDINANCE ANNEXING PROPERTY TO THE VILLAGE OF  
PRIOR LAKE, MINNESOTA

WHEREAS, Scott-Rice Telephone Company, Inc., being the sole owner of the following described property, lying in Scott County, Minnesota:

Land in Southeast Quarter of the Northwest Quarter (SE $\frac{1}{4}$ ) of NW $\frac{1}{4}$  of Section 2, Twp. 114, Range 22, Scott County, Minnesota, described as follows:

Starting at a point on the South Line of Pleasant Ave. and 2 rods West of the North and South Quarter line thru said Section 2, running thence West along the South Line of Pleasant Ave. 150 feet, thence South 150 feet, thence East 150 feet, thence North 150 feet to the place of beginning. Containing fifty two hundredths acres;

Starting at a point 33 feet West of the North and South quarter section line thru Section 2 and 139 feet South of the center line of Pleasant Ave. as shown on the Plat of "West Side Addition to Prior Lake" and running thence West parallel to Pleasant Ave. 150 feet, thence South Parallel to the Quarter Section line 100 feet, thence East 150 feet, thence North 100 feet to the place of beginning. Containing 0.34 acres;

Starting at a point 33 feet West of the North and South quarter section line thru Section 2 and 133 feet South of the center line of Pleasant Ave. as shown on the Plat of "West Side Addition to Prior Lake" and running thence West parallel to Pleasant Ave. 150 feet, thence South parallel to the Quarter Section line 100 feet, thence East 150 feet, thence North 100 feet to the place of beginning. Containing 0.34 acres;

which lies outside the corporate limits of the Village of Prior Lake, Minnesota, be and the same is hereby annexed to the Village of Prior Lake, Minnesota, and said property is hereby declared to be an addition to said Village.

Upon the date of execution of this Ordinance, such property shall become a part of said Village as effectively as if it had been originally a part thereof.

SECTION 2.

This Ordinance shall take effect and be in force from and after its passage and publication and after filing as hereinafter set forth. The Village Clerk is hereby directed to cause certified copies of this Ordinance to be recorded and filed in the Office of the Register of Deeds of Scott County, Minnesota, the Office of the County Auditor, Scott County, Minnesota, the Office of the Secretary of the Municipal Commission, State of Minnesota, and in the Office of the Secretary of State of the State of Minnesota.
