ORDINANCE No. 65-04

AN ORDINANCE AMENDING TO THE VILLAGE OF WINSTED, MINNESOTA, CERTAIN UNPLATTED LAND IN WINSTED TOWNSHIP ADJOINING AND LYING EASTERNLY OF EAST STREET SOUTH AND SOUTHWEST CORNER THE SOUTHWEST AND SOUTH SIDE LINE OF WINSTED LAKE AND THE NORTH RIGHT OF WAY LINE OF THE ELECTRIC SHORT LINE RAILROAD, BEING A PART OF GOVERNMENT LOTS 4 and 5, SECTION 11, TOWNSHIP 117 NORTH OF RANGE 27 WEST, McLEOD COUNTY, MINNESOTA.

THE VILLAGE COUNCIL OF WINSTED HEREBY ORDAINS:

Section 1. The Winsted Area Business Development Corporation is the sole owner of the land hereinafter described, which land abuts upon the present territorial limits of the Village of Winsted; and as such owner, it has petitioned the Mayor and Council of the Village of Winsted to annex such land to, and to include within, the Village of Winsted, McLeod County, Minnesota, and further, to adopt an Ordinance annexing such land to the Village. Such land is located in Winsted Township, McLeod County, Minnesota, and is described as follows:

That part of Lot 5 and 4, Section 11, Township 117 North, Range 27 West, described as follows: Commencing at a point 15 feet North of the Northeast corner of the Southwest Quarter Section 11, Township 117 North, Range 27 West, said point being on the North Right of Way Line of the Electric Short Line Ry. Co.; thence North along the West line of Lot 4, said Section 11, for 870.00 feet to the waters edge of Lake Winsted, thence Southeasterly along the waters edge of Lake Winsted for 1986 feet to a point where said waters edge intersects the North Right of Way Line of said Railroad; thence along said North Right of Way Line in a Northwestorly direction for 1519 feet to the point of commencement, containing 19 acres, more or less.

Section 2. The Mayor and Council of the Village of Winsted hereby determine that the land described in Section 1, above abuts upon the present territorial limits of the Village of Winsted, and is so conditioned as to be properly subjected to village or municipal government, and the annexation of said land will be in the best interests of the Village of Winsted and the land affected.

Section 3. Therefore, the land described in Section 1, above is hereby annexed, added to and made a part of the Village of Winsted, Minnesota, as effectually as if it had originally been a part thereof.

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Section 4. This Ordinance shall take effect and be in force from and after its official publication and from and after the filing of a certified copy hereof with the Minnesota Municipal Commission, the McLeod County Auditor and the Secretary of State of the State of Minnesota.

Passed by the Village Council of the Village of Winsted this 8<sup>th</sup> day of June, 1965.
