

ORDINANCE NO. 305

AN ORDINANCE EXTENDING THE CORPORATE LIMITS OF THE CITY OF MARSHALL TO INCLUDE CERTAIN UNFLATTED LAND NOT EXCEEDING TWO HUNDRED ACRES.

The Common Council of the City of Marshall do ordain as follows:

Section 1. A petition has been filed with the Common Council of the City of Marshall, Minnesota by the sole owner of the following described real estate in the County of Lyon, State of Minnesota, to have such land included within the City of Marshall, Minnesota:

Section 8, Township 111 North, Range 41 West, described as follows: Commencing at the Northwest corner of said Section 8, thence easterly along North section line of said Section 8, Twelve Hundred Twelve and Eight Tenths (1212.8) feet, thence South 00 degrees, 12 minutes East to a point on the Northwesterly right-of-way line of the Willmar and Sioux Falls Railroad which is point of beginning; thence South 00 degrees, 12 minutes East One Hundred Fifteen (115) feet to a point on the Southeasterly right-of-way line of said railroad, thence Southwesterly along said right-of-way line Three Hundred Forty One (341) feet, thence at right angles right, One Hundred (100) feet to a point on the Northwesterly right-of-way line of said railroad, thence Northeasterly along said right-of-way line Four Hundred Three and Forty-seven One Hundredths (403.47 feet to point of beginning.)

Section 2. The quantity of land embraced within the foregoing description, and bounded as described, is 0.85 acres, more or less.

Section 3. The Common Council hereby determines (1) that the annexation will be to the best interests of the City of Marshall, Minnesota and of the territory affected; and (2) that the territory described herein abuts upon the City and is so conditioned as properly to be subjected to City government.

Section 4. Therefore, the City of Marshall, Minnesota hereby ordains and declares that the property hereinbefore described be and the same is hereby annexed to, and included in, the City of Marshall, Minnesota, as effectually as if it had originally been a part thereof.

Section 5. This ordinance shall be final and shall take effect and be in force from and after filing certified copy thereof with the Minnesota Municipal Commission, the County Auditor and the Secretary of State, and from and after its passage and publication.


