## ORDINANCE NO. 303

AN ORDINANCE EXTENDING THE CORPORATE LIMITS OF THE GITY OF MARSHALL TO INCLUDE CERTAIN UNFLATTED LAND NOT EXCEEDING TWO HUNDRED ACRES.

The Common Council of the City of Marchall do erdsin as follows:

Section 1. A petition has been filed with the Common Gouncil of the City Marshall, Minnesota by the sole owner of the following described real wife in the County of Lyon, State of Minnesota, to have such land included within the City of Marshall, Minresota:
