



ORDINANCE NO. 250

AN ORDINANCE ANNEXING TERRITORY ABUTTING UPON THE
CITY OF CLOQUET

The City Council of the City of Cloquet do ordain as follows:

Section 1. The Council of the City of Cloquet hereby finds and determines that the land described in a petition filed with the Clerk asking that certain property therein described be annexed to the City of Cloquet; that it abutts upon the City of Cloquet; that it is not included in any other village, city or borough; that the owners of the property described in said petition have signed the same.

The Council of the City of Cloquet further finds and determines that the area in territory described in said petition is of such physical characteristics, terrain and formation that it readily lends itself to municipal development as part of the community of Cloquet and is so conditioned as properly to be subjected to city government.

The City Council of Cloquet further finds and determines that the annexation will be to the best interests of the City of Cloquet and the territory affected and described in said petition.

Section 2. The City of Cloquet pursuant to the petition of the owners of the property hereinafter described, petitioning and requesting the annexation thereof, which petition is on file with the Clerk, hereby annexes and declares said hereinafter described premises to be annexed to the City of Cloquet, which premises consists of a tract of land situated in the County of Carlton, State of Minnesota, described as follows, to-wit:

The Northwest Quarter of Northeast Quarter of Northeast Quarter
(NW $\frac{1}{4}$ of NE $\frac{1}{4}$ of NE $\frac{1}{4}$), Section Twenty-six (26), Township Forty-nine (49),
North, of Range Seventeen (17), West of the 4th Principal Meridian,
Carlton County, containing 10.09 acres and being subject to the rights
of public road on the North side, now designated as Washington Avenue.

This ordinance shall take effect and be in force from and after its passage and publication.

1. $\frac{1}{2}$ of $\text{NE}\frac{1}{4}$ of $\text{NW}\frac{1}{4}$, Section 25, Township 49, Range 17.

EXCEPT:

- a. The West 343.5 feet.
- b. Beginning at a point on the NW corner of North line a distance of 443.5 feet going East, thence south parallel with west line of $\text{NE}\frac{1}{4}$ of $\text{NW}\frac{1}{4}$ 200 feet, thence west parallel with north line of $\text{NE}\frac{1}{4}$ of $\text{NW}\frac{1}{4}$ 100 feet, thence north parallel with west line of $\text{NE}\frac{1}{4}$ of $\text{NW}\frac{1}{4}$ 200 feet.

2. $\frac{1}{2}$ of $\text{NE}\frac{1}{4}$ of $\text{NW}\frac{1}{4}$, Section 25, Township 49, Range 17.

EXCEPT:

- a. The East 330 feet.
