ORDINANCE NO. 231

An Ordinance Annexing Territory Herein Described to the City of Shakopee  
WHEREAS, The territory hereinafter described is located wholly within the  
Township of Jackson, Scott County, Minnesota, and does not abut any other township  
but does lie adjacent to the City of Shakopee, and

WHEREAS, An amended Petition has been duly made and filed praying for the  
annexation of said property to the City of Shakopee and said Petition was signed  
by all the owners of said tract as provided by MSA 414.03.

THE COMMON COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF SHAKOPEE DO ORDAIN:

SECTION I: Preamble

Due notice has been given of the intention to introduce this ordinance pursuant  
of  
to the Charter of the City of Shakopee and/the annexation of the property hereinafter  
described and that the annexation thereof to the City of Shakopee would be to the  
best interests of the City of Shakopee and the territory affected.

SECTION II: Annexation

That the following described territory be, and the same is, hereby annexed to,  
declared to be and hereby does become a part of the City of Shakopee, to-wit:

All that part of the west Half of the Northeast Quarter (W $\frac{1}{2}$  of NE $\frac{1}{4}$ ),  
lying south of the Southwily right of way line of State Highway #160  
as now constructed, all being in Section Eleven (11), Township One  
Hundred Fifteen (115), Range Twenty-three (23), Scott County, Minnesota,  
containing approximately 77.75 acres more or less, subject to Highway  
Department easements.

SECTION III: When In Force

This ordinance shall be in force and effect from and after its passage and  
publication as required by law and upon the filing of a copy hereof with the Municipal  
Commission, the County Auditor and the Secretary of State of the State of Minnesota.

SECTION IV: Filing and Recording

Immediately upon the passage and publication hereof, a copy duly certified to  
by the City Recorder under the seal of the City of Shakopee be forthwith filed with  
the Municipal Commission of the State of Minnesota, an identical copy be filed with  
the County Auditor of Scott County, Minnesota, and an identical copy to filed with  
the Secretary of State of the State of Minnesota, and an identical copy to forthwith  
filed for record in the office of the Registrar of Titles and the Registrar of Deeds  
of Scott County, Minnesota.

SECTION II: Annexation

All that part of the West Half of the Northeast Quarter (0 $\frac{1}{2}$  of NE $\frac{1}{4}$ ),  
lying south of the Southerly right of way line of State Highway 115  
as now constructed, all being in Section Eleven (11), Township One  
Hundred Fifteen (115), Range Twenty-three (23), Scott County, Minnesota,  
containing approximately 77.75 acres more or less, subject to Highway  
Department easements.

SECTION III: When In Force

This ordinance shall be in force and effect from and after its passage and  
publication as required by law and upon the filing of a copy hereof with the Municipal  
Commission, the County Auditor and the Secretary of State of the State of Minnesota.

SECTION IV: Filing and Recording

Immediately upon the passage and publication hereof, a copy duly certified to  
by the City Recorder under the seal of the City of Shakopee be forthwith filed with  
the Municipal Commission of the State of Minnesota, an identical copy be filed with  
the County Auditor of Scott County, Minnesota, and an identical copy be filed with  
the Secretary of State of the State of Minnesota, and an identical copy be forthwith  
filed for record in the office of the Registrar of Titles and the Register of Deeds  
of Scott County, Minnesota.
