

ORDINANCE NO. 378

AN ORDINANCE EXTENDING THE CORPORATE LIMITS OF THE CITY OF WORTHINGTON, MINNESOTA, TO INCLUDE CERTAIN UNPLATTED LANDS.

The City Council of the City of Worthington Do Ordain:

Section 1. A petition has been filed with the City Council of the City of Worthington, Minnesota, signed by all the owners in number of the following described real estate to have such land included within the City of Worthington, Minnesota:

That part of Section Thirteen (13), Township One Hundred Two (102) North, Range Forty (40) West, and of Section Eighteen (18), Township One Hundred Two (102) North, Range Thirty-Nine (39) West, all in Nobles County, Minnesota, bounded and described as follows:

Commencing at the west property line of Spring Avenue projected and the south line of Section 13, Township 102 North, Range 40 West; thence in a northerly direction along the extension of Spring Avenue to a northerly right-of-way line of Minnesota Trunk Highway No. 60; thence northeasterly along the northwesterly line of said highway to the east line of said Section 13; thence northerly along said section line for 1575.21 feet; thence southeasterly at an interior angle of 86° 09' 25" for 245.36 feet; thence northeasterly on a 6.86° curve for 653.91 feet; thence southeasterly along the tangent line of said curve for 640.31 feet, more or less, to the northeasterly right-of-way line of the Chicago, Northwestern Railway Company; thence southwesterly along said right-of-way line to the south line of said Section 13; thence westerly along said south line to the point of beginning.

Section 2. The quantity of land embraced within the foregoing description, and bounded and described is 28 acres.

Section 3. Notice was duly given the Board of Commissioners for Nobles County, the Board of Commissioners for Worthington Township and the Board of Commissioners for Lorain Township on May 18, 1965, that said matter was being considered by the City Council of the City of Worthington and a hearing was duly held by the City Council of the City of Worthington, on the proposed annexation after publication of notice of hearing as required by City Charter.

Section 4. The City Council hereby determines (1) that the annexation will be to the best interests of the City of Worthington, Minnesota, and of the territory affected; (2) that the territory described herein abuts upon the City and is so conditioned as properly to be subjected to City government.

Section 5. The corporate limits of the city are hereby extended to include the property described in Section 1, and the same is hereby annexed to, and included in the City as effectually as if it had originally been a part thereof.

Section 6. The City Clerk is hereby directed to file certified copies of this ordinance with the Minnesota Municipal Commission, the County Auditor and the Secretary of State.

Section 7. This ordinance shall take effect upon its passage and publication and upon the filing of the certified copies as directed in Section 6.
