Printers Affidavit of Publication

(Chapter 134, Laws of 1955.)

STATE OF MINNESOTA,
County of Freeborn, ss.

Wayne F. Wright, being duly sworn, on oath says; that he is, and during all the times herein stated has been the managing editor of the newspaper known as The Alden Advance, and has full knowledge of the facts hereinafter stated; that for more

than one year prior to the publication therein of the Alden Advance

hereinafter described, said

newspaper was printed and published in the Village of Alden, in the County of Freeborn, State of Minnesota, on Thursday of each week; that during all said time said newspaper has been printed in the English language from its known office of publication within the city from which it purports to be issued as above stated and in newspaper format and in column and sheet form equivalent in space to at least 450 running inches of single column, two inches wide; has been issued once each week from a known office established in said place of publication and employing skilled workmen and the necessary material for preparing and printing the same; that the press work on that part of the newspaper devoted to local news of interest to the community it purports to serve has been done in its known office of publication; that during all said time in its makeup not less than twenty-five percent of its news columns have been devoted to local news of interest to the community it purports to serve; that during all said time it has not wholly duplicated any other publication and has not been entirely made of patents, plate matter and advertisements; has been circulated in and near its said place of publication to the extent of at least two hundred and forty (240) copies regularly delivered to paying subscribers and has entry as second class matter in its local post office; that a copy of each issue has been filed with the State Historical Society, St. Paul, Minnesota; that there has been on file in the office of the County Auditor of Freeborn County, Minnesota, the affidavit of a person having knowledge of the facts, showing the name and location of said newspaper and the existence of the conditions constituting its qualifications as a legal newspaper.

That the Alden Advance No. 29

hereto attached was cut from the columns of said newspaper, and was printed and

published in the English language, once each week for one successive

weeks; that it was first so published on Thursday, the 27 day of

May 1965; and thereafter on Thursday of each week

to and including the day of 19 ; and that the

following is a printed copy of the lower case alphabet from A to Z, both inclusive, and is hereby acknowledged as being the size and kind of type used in the composition and publication of said notice, to-wit:

ORDINANCE NO. 29
An ordinance annexing certain lands and premises to the corporate limits of the village of Freeborn, Minnesota.
The Village Council of Freeborn ordains:
Whereas, Stanley Getskow and Janice Getskow, Husband and Wife, have petitioned the Village Council of the Village of Freeborn, requesting the annexation to the Village of Freeborn the following described property, to wit; a tract of land described as follows: Commencing at a point that is 396 ft. due west of the southeast corner of the NW 1/4, which is the point of beginning; thence to a point due north 200 ft.; thence due east to a point 150 ft.; thence due south to a point 200 ft.; thence due west 150 ft.; to the point of beginning; all in Section 35, Township 104, Range 23 west. Also known as Lots 7-8-9 Block 21. As platted or as formerly platted, together with as much of adjacent streets and alleys which may have accrued to said premises by reason of vacated streets or alleys, and subject to any street easements. Abutting upon and adjacent to the incorporated Village of Freeborn, be and the same are hereby annexed to said village and shall become a part of such village, as effectual as if it had been originally a part thereof.
