- WHEREAS, more young Minnesotans ages 16 through 21, will be leaving school in June and seeking employment in greater numbers this year than ever before in our history, and
- WHEREAS, youth represents the future of our State and our Nation and is our most important resource, and
- WHEREAS, these young people must be given opportunities for employment and training that will prepare them for their future roles of responsibility and leadership in their communities, and
- WHEREAS, the President of the United States has called upon all Federal and State and Local Governmental agencies and departments and private employers to cooperate in creating extra employment opportunities this summer over and above the opportunities that would normally arise,
- NOW, THEREFORE, I, Karl F. Rolvaag, Governor of the State of Minnesota, do hereby proclaim the month of June, 1965, as

"YOUTH OPPORTUNITY MONTH"

and call upon all citizens and private employers in this State to render every assistance and cooperation in developing work and training opportunities for our young people to provide them with experiences that will help them in their future years.
