

PROCLAMATION

WHEREAS, the United States of America, pursuant to federal law and rules and regulations promulgated thereunder, will be able to make available to the State of Minnesota funds for a study of reducing the production and distribution costs of Minnesota peat, and

WHEREAS, no state agency has been otherwise designated by law to apply for, receive and accept federal funds, and

WHEREAS, the United States of America has proposed a contract No. C-298-65 (NEC) to conduct a study to investigate the feasibility of reducing production and distribution costs of Minnesota peat to a competitive level, and

WHEREAS, the United States of America has indicated willingness to contract with the State of Minnesota through the Department of Iron Range Resources and Rehabilitation,

NOW, THEREFORE, I, Karl F. Rolvaag, Governor of the State of Minnesota, hereby designate, pursuant to Laws 1965, Chapter 901, Section 87, the Department of Iron Range Resources and Rehabilitation as the state agency for such purpose.
