PROCLAMATION

WHEREAS, the United States of America, pursuant to Title IV of the Economic Opportunity Act of 1965, Public Law 88-452, will be able to make available to the State of Minnesota funds for the use of youths to work on certain tax forfeited lands in the State of Minnesota, and
WHEREAS, no state agency has been otherwise designated by law to apply for, receive and accept such federal funds, and
WHEREAS, the United States of America has proposed the following project:

NYC Proposal No. 04-77-25

Relating to the use of youths to work on tax forfeited lands in Aitkin, Becker, Beltrami, Cass, Clearwater, Crow Wing, Hubbard, Itasca, Koochiching, St. Louis and Wadena Counties to prepare sites, prune, set up fire controls, access roads, do blaster rust control and help in the relocation of boundary markers.

and,

WHEREAS, the United States of America has indicated willingness to contract with the State of Minnesota through the Department of Iron Range Resources and Rehabilitation.

NOW, THEREFORE, I, Karl F. Polvraay, Governor of the State of Minnesota, hereby designate, pursuant to laws 1965, Chapter 901, Section 87, the Department of Iron Range Resources and Rehabilitation as the state agency for such purpose.
