WHEREAS, the understanding and support of all citizens is necessary to building and maintaining of our far-reaching Air Force, and


WHEREAS, there is an urgent need for qualified nurses in the United States Air Force Corps.


NOW, THEREFORE, I, Karl F. Rolvaag, Governor of the State of Minnesota, do hereby proclaim the week of July 1, 1965, as

"AIR FORCE NURSE WEEK"


