PROCLAMATION

WHEREAS, on July 5, 1965, the United States Secret Service will have acted diligently for 100 years to protect the integrity of the Nation's currency and securities by suppressing counterfeiting and forgery, and

WHEREAS, the United States Secret Service, through its investigative work, has played a vital role in countless significant events in the history of our Nation, and since 1901 its agents have provided protection of our Presidents, even at the cost of their own lives, and

WHEREAS, through their selfless sacrifices in protecting the public welfare, agents of the United States Secret Service have earned the respect and admiration of the citizens of this State and of the Nation, and

WHEREAS, this select corps of agents is today more closely allied with law enforcement agencies in Minnesota and throughout the Nation, thereby creating even greater demands on its services and dedication than ever before,

NOW, THEREFORE, I, Karl F. Rolvaag, Governor of Minnesota, do hereby proclaim the week of July 5 to July 11, 1965, as

"UNITED STATES SECRET SERVICE WEEK"

In Minnesota, and I urge all citizens and appropriate public and private organizations to extend congratulations to agents of the United States Secret Service, on this, its centennial.
