

PROCLAMATION

WHEREAS, the President of the United States has proclaimed the week of October 3, 1965 as Fire Prevention Week, and

WHEREAS, the loss of life and property by fire every year throughout the nation mounts, and

WHEREAS, experience has shown that effective community fire prevention programs can save lives and property and preserve our resources otherwise needlessly lost,

NOW, THEREFORE, I, Karl F. Rolvaag, Governor of the State of Minnesota, do hereby proclaim the week of October 3, 1965, as

"FIRE PREVENTION WEEK"

in Minnesota, and urge State and local government officials to join with schools, civic groups and public information agencies in promoting programs that will remind us all of our responsibility to assist in eliminating this careless waste of life and property.
