- WHEREAS, the discussions of the issues attendant upon a brotherhood drive are beneficial to all, and
- WHEREAS, the Minnesota Task Force is again conducting a "Brotherhood Cotton Week" Drive, and

NOW, THEREFORE, I, Karl F. Rolvaag, Governor of the State of Minnesota, do hereby proclaim the week of August 1, 1965, as

"BROTHERHOOD COTTON WEEK"

in Minnesota, and urge all Minnesotans to express their concern for their brother's liberties by supporting this "Brotherhood Cotton Week" campaign.
