- WHEREAS, over 600 contestants have enrolled in the various categories coming from every corner of the state of Minnesota,

NOW, THEREFORE, I, Karl F. Rolvaag, Governor of the State of Minnesota, do hereby proclaim August 28 and 29, 1965, as

"ACCORDION DAYS"

in Minnesota, and do urge all citizens to enjoy and appreciate the music and the efforts of the Minnesota Accordion Guild.
