DESIGNATION OF STATE AGENCY TO RECEIVE FEDERAL FUNDS.

WHEREAS, the state legislature in Laws 1965, Chapter 623 enacted a law providing for the promulgation of a State Building Code under the direction of the Commissioner of Administration, and

WHEREAS, said law failed to provide the authority for the acceptance of federal funds for the purposes of such code, and

WHEREAS, there is a possibility that the federal government through the Secretary of Commerce will provide federal funds for the purposes of a State Building Code, and

WHEREAS, the legislature in Laws 1965, Chapter 901, Section 87 has provided that the Governor of the State of Minnesota may receive and accept federal funds when no other law provides for such, and that the Governor may designate a state agency to act for him in applying for federal funds pursuant to this section;

NOW, THEREFORE, pursuant to the authority of Laws 1965, Chapter 901, Section 87, the Commissioner of Administration is hereby designated the state agency to apply for, receive and accept any funds which are offered by the federal government for the purposes of promulgating a State Building Code pursuant to Laws 1965, Chapter 623.
