- WHEREAS, the Charter which created the Alliance for Progress was completed and signed during a meeting of all the American Republics in Punta del Este, Uruguay, on August 17th, 1961, and
- WHEREAS, this unprecedented example of peacetime cooperation has awakened the creative energies of our people, leading them to auspicious gains in social and economic development, and
- WHEREAS, in their supreme effort to meet the goals set at Punta del Este the American republics are mobilizing their resources and enlisting the energies of their people in a determined effort to modify their social patterns, so that all may share in the sacrifices and fruits of growth, and
- WHEREAS, the people of Minnesota, having joined in partnership with Uruguay to accomplish the basic goals of the Alliance for Progress, have a special interest in its success,

NOW, THEREFORE, I, Karl F. Rolvaag, Governor of the State of Minnesota, hereby proclaim the week of August 17, 1965 as

"ALLIANCE FOR PROGRESS WEEK"

in Minnesota, and call on my fellow citizens to join our fellow Americans in our sister republics in prayer and work for the continued success of the Alliance for Progress.

IN WITNESS WHEREOF, I have hereunto set my hand and caused the Great Seal of the State of Minnesota to be affixed at the State Capitol this nineteenth day of August in the year of our Lord one thousand nine hundred and sixty-five and of the State, the one hundred eighth.
