## EXECUTIVE ORDER NO. 20

IN THE MATTER OF THE APPLICATION OF THE HONORABLE EDWARD J. HINIKER, JUDGE OF THE PROBATE COURT OF DAKOTA COUNTY, MINNESOTA, FOR RETIREMENT UNDER AND PURSUANT TO THE PROVISIONS OF MINNESOTA STATUTES 1961, SECTIONS 490.11 AND 490.12, SUBDIVISION 1.

## ORDER FOR RETIREMENT

WHEREAS, The Honorable Edward J. Hiniker, Judge of the Probate Court of Dakota County, Minnesota, has heretofore filed with the undersigned Governor of the State of Minnesota his written application for retirement because of physical incapacity, said application having been made under and pursuant to the provisions of Minnesota Statutes 1961, Sections 490.11 and 490.12, Subdivision 1,

WHEREAS, said Judge Hiniker has set forth in his application "That he is suffering a loss of hearing which has, since December, 1963, gradually become more pronounced; that at the present time it is, at times, almost impossible for him to conduct probate and juvenile court hearings and interviews in his office; that he has consulted ear specialists and is advised that there is no cure for his hearing loss; that he has used hearing aids recommended to him by hearing aid specialists and finds the same unsatisfactory and inadequate".

WHEREAS, the undersigned, upon investigation, has determined that Judge Hiniker has such physical disability that he has become incapacitated physically from performing his judicial duties during the remainder of his term of office, and that the public service is suffering and will continue to suffer by reason of such disability, and

WHEREAS, Judge Hiniker is 67 years of age and has served as Probate Judge of Dakota County for a period of more than 28 years,

NOW, THEREFORE, I, KARL F. ROLVAAG, Governor of the State of Minnesota, in pursuance to the provisions of the said section 490.11, do hereby order and direct the retirement of the said Honorable Edward J. Hiniker, Judge of the Probate Court of Dakota County, Minnesota, effective September 1, 1965, for the unexpired portion of his term for which said Judge was elected, which term expires the first Monday in January, 1969, and direct that this order be filed in the office of the Secretary of State of the State of Minnesota, and that the said Judge Hiniker shall receive the compensation allotted to his office for the remainder of his term, and thereafter he shall receive one-half of the compensation allotted to his office at the time of such retirement for the remainder of his life, as provided in Minnesota Statutes 1961, Section 490.12, Subdivision 1.
