

PROCLAMATION

- WHEREAS, all efforts to reduce the toll of accidents on our streets and highways are of vital importance, and
- WHEREAS, the American Safety League has been actively promoting a program aimed at educating school children in safe travel habits and in enlisting parents, teachers, public safety officials, and all drivers of motor vehicles in the development of habits of extra caution whenever children are in action, and
- WHEREAS, these programs are conducted mainly under the auspices of local departments of police with the cooperation of concerned citizens, and
- WHEREAS, Governors of more than thirty States have issued proclamations,

NOW, THEREFORE, I, Karl F. Rolvaag, Governor of the State of Minnesota, do hereby proclaim the week of September 8 - 15, 1965, as

"NATIONAL CHILD SAFETY WEEK"

in Minnesota, and urge widest public attention to the education of all in the interest of greater safety for our children.
