ORDINANCE NO. 39

VILLAGE ORDINANCE AMENDING LAWS

The Village Council of the Village of Genvick does hereby ordain as follows:

Section 1. The following described land, abutting the municipality of Genvick, Minnesota, is hereby annexed to and made a part of the incorporated territory of the Village of Genvick, Minnesota, to-wit:

The East Fifteen (15) acres of the Northeast quarter of the Southwest quarter (NE^{1/4}SW^{1/4}), Section Ten (10), Township One Hundred Forty-nine (149) North, Range Thirty-eight (38) West, less the platted portion thereof; and also

The West Half of the Southeast quarter (SW^{1/2}SE^{1/4}), Section Ten (10), Township One Hundred Forty-nine (149) North, Range Thirty-eight (38) West, all of the Fifth Principal Meridian, according to the government survey thereof, except the railway right of way and that part thereof lying south of the railway right of way, and also less the following described tract thereof, to-wit: Commencing at a point on the west quarter line of said Southwest quarter of the Southeast quarter (SW^{1/4}SE^{1/4}) where said quarter line intersects the center line of the Sault Ste. Marie Railway (presently known as the Soo Line) right of way, thence North Fifty (50) feet to the North right of way line of said railway as the point of beginning; thence continuing North on said quarter line, a distance of Four Hundred (400) feet; thence at right angles and east, a distance of Four Hundred Twenty (420) feet; thence at right angles and South, to the North right of way line of the Sault Ste. Marie Railway; thence Northwesterly along the railway right of way line, to the point of beginning.

Section 2. The Village Council of the Village of Genvick hereby determines that the annexation of the above described tract of land will be to the best interest of the municipality of Genvick, Minnesota, and of the above described territory and that this annexation is made pursuant to M.S.A. Section 414.05, Subd. 2.

Section 3. This ordinance shall take effect and be in force from and after its publication.



PETITION FOR ANNEXATION
OF LAND TO VILLAGE

TO THE VILLAGE COUNCIL OF THE VILLAGE OF GENVICK:

Your undersigned petitioners represent and state:

That they are the owners as joint tenants, and not as tenants in common, of the territory hereinafter described abutting the Village of Genvick, Minnesota, and that said territory is not included in any other village, city, or borough and that said territory is so conditioned as properly to be subjected to village government, and that it will be to the best interests of the municipality and of the territory affected to have such land annexed to the Village of Genvick, and further that said land is unplatted and does not exceed Two Hundred (200) acres.

Your petitioners, therefore, hereby petition the Village Council of the Village of Genvick, Minnesota, to have the following described property located in the County of Clearwater, and State of Minnesota, annexed to and made a part of the incorporated territory of said Village, to-wit:

The East Fifteen (15) acres of the Northeast quarter of the Southwest quarter (NE1/4), Section Ten (10), Township One Hundred Forty-nine (149) North, Range Thirty-eight (38) West, less the platted portion thereof; and also

The West Half of the Southeast quarter (SW1/2), Section Ten (10), Township One Hundred Forty-nine (149) North, Range Thirty-eight (38) West, all of the Fifth Principal Meridian, according to the government survey thereof, except the railway right of way and that part thereof lying south of the railway right of way, and also less the following described tract thereof, to-wit: Commencing at a point on the West quarter line of said Southwest quarter of the Southeast quarter (SW1/4) where said quarter line intersects the center line of the Sault Ste. Marie Railway (presently known as the See Line) right of way, thence North Fifty (50) Feet to the North right of way line of said railway as the point of beginning; thence continuing North on said quarter line, a distance of Four Hundred (400) Feet; thence at right angles and East, a distance of Four Hundred Twenty (420) Feet; thence at right angles and South, to the North right of way line of the Sault Ste. Marie Railway; thence Northwest along the railway right of way line, to the point of beginning,

and pray that you proceed to hear and grant this petition.
