ORDINANCE NO. 39

VILLAGE ORDINANCE AMENDING LAND

The Village Council of the Village of Genwick does hereby ordain as follows:

Section 1. The following described land, abutting the municipality of Genwick, Minnesota, is hereby annexed to and made a part of the incorporated territory of the Village of Genwick, Minnesota, to-wit:

The East Fifteen (15) acres of the Northeast Quarter of the Southwest Quarter (NW<sup>1/4</sup>SW<sup>1/4</sup>), Section Ten (10), Township One Hundred Forty-nine (149) North, Range Thirty-eight (38) West, less the platted portion thereof; and also

The West Half of the Southeast Quarter (SW<sup>1/2</sup>SE<sup>1/4</sup>), Section Ten (10), Township One Hundred Forty-nine (149) North, Range Thirty-eight (38) West, all of the Fifth Principal Meridian, according to the government survey thereof, except the railway right of way and that part thereof lying south of the railway right of way, and also less the following described tract thereof, to-wit: Commencing at a point on the west quarter line of said Southwest Quarter of the Southeast Quarter (SW<sup>1/2</sup>SE<sup>1/4</sup>) where said quarter line intersects the center line of the Sault Ste. Marie Railway (presently known as the Soo Line) right of way, thence North Fifty (50) Feet to the North right of way line of said railway as the point of beginning; thence continuing North on said quarter line, a distance of Four Hundred (400) Feet; thence at right angles east, a distance of Four Hundred Twenty (420) Feet; thence at right angles and South, to the North right of way line of the Sault Ste. Marie Railway; thence Northwesterly along the railway right of way line, to the point of beginning.

Section 2. The Village Council of the Village of Genwick hereby determines that the annexation of the above described tract of land will be to the best interest of the municipality of Genwick, Minnesota, and of the above described territory and that this annexation is made pursuant to M.S.A. Section 414.03, Subd. 2.

Section 3. This ordinance shall take effect and be in force from and after its publication.

TO THE VILLAGE COUNCIL OF THE VILLAGE OF CONVICTION:

Your undersigned petitioners represent and state:
