ORDINANCE 44

An Ordinance Intending the Corporate  
Limits of the Village of Hamburg, to  
Exclude Certain Unplatted Land not  
exceeding 200 acres.

Section 1. A petition has been filed with the governing body  
of the Village of Hamburg, Minnesota, by R. W.  
Graumann and wife Graumann, husband and wife,  
the sole owners of the following described real estate to have  
such land included within the Village of Hamburg, Minnesota:

Commencing at a point 284 rods North of the  
Southwest corner of Section 29, Township 115  
North of Range 26 West; thence running North  
along Section Line between Sections 28 and 29  
a distance of 90 feet to a point; thence West  
parallel to Section Line between Sections 29  
and 32, a distance of 165 feet to a point;  
thence South parallel with Section Line between  
Sections 28 and 29, a distance of 90 feet to a  
point; thence East parallel with Section Line  
between Sections 29 and 32 a distance of 165  
feet to the place of beginning.

Lying and being in the Southwest Quarter of the  
Southwest Quarter of Section 29, Township 115  
North of Range 26 West, and containing .34 acre  
more or less.

Section 2. The quantity of land embraced within the foregoing  
description, and bounded as described, is .34  
acres.

Section 3. The Village Council hereby doth ordain (1) that  
the annexation will be to the best interest of  
the Village of Hamburg, Minn., and of the terri-  
tory affected; (2) that the territory described herein abutts  
upon the Village of Hamburg and is so situated as properly to  
be subjected to Village Government.

Section 4. Whereas the Village of Hamburg Minnesota hereby  
ordains and declares that the property hereinbefore  
described be and the same is hereby annexed to,  
and included in the Village of Hamburg, Minnesota, as effectually  
as if it had originally been a part thereof.

Section 5. This Ordinance shall be filed and shall take effect  
and be in force from and after filing a certified  
copy thereof with the Minnesota Municipal Commission, the County  
Attalaor, and the Secretary of State, and from and after its passage,  
and publication.
