EXTENDING THE CORPORATE LIMITS OF THE CITY OF AUSTIN.

WHEREAS, the following described property is entirely surrounded by property now within the Corporate limits of the City of Austin, and are subject to incorporation within the corporate limits of the City of Austin, and

WHEREAS, said premises hereinafter described are about to become urban in character and municipal government of the area hereinafter described is required in order to protect the public health, safety and welfare of said territory, and annexation of the premises hereinafter described is with the best interest of the City of Austin and the territory to be annexed, and

WHEREAS, said premises are well fitted to be under municipal government and are well adapted for municipal use, and

WHEREAS, a public hearing was held on the proposal to annex said property on July 29, 1964 at 8:00 P.M., notice in writing having been given to all of the owners affected and notice of said hearing having been published in the Austin Daily Herald;

NOW THEREFORE, THE COMMON COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF AUSTIN, MINNESOTA, DO ORDAIN:

SECTION 1. The land hereinafter described is to be added to and incorporated within the corporate limits of the City of Austin, Minnesota, and said Common Council does hereby declare said premises hereinafter described to be urban in character and to be incorporated within and to be a part of the City of Austin, Minnesota. The premises are to be described as follows:

Commencing at the southwest corner of the southwest quarter of Section 36, Township 103 North, Range 18 West; thence north along the west line of said section to the north right of way line of Interstate Highway No. 90; thence easterly along the north right of way line to the west line of Lot 4, Block 2, Robbins Crest addition to the City of Austin, this being the point of beginning; thence northerly along this west line extended north to the corporate limits of the City of Austin, this point being 789.7 feet north of the south line of Section 36; thence southwesterly at a deflection angle to the left of  $117^{\circ} 10'$ , a distance of 713.5 feet along the corporate limit line; thence south at a

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deflection angle to the left of  $62^{\circ} 50'$  to a point where this line intersects the north right of way line of Interstate Highway No. 90; thence easterly along this north right of way line to the point of beginning.

SECTION 2. The above described land extending the corporate limits of the City of Austin shall be added at the end of Chapter 2300, Austin Compilation in the regular chronological order.

SECTION 3. Copies of this Ordinance shall be filed with the Municipal Commission, the County Auditor of Mower County, Minnesota, and with the Secretary of State of Minnesota.

SECTION 4. This Ordinance takes effect upon its passage and publishing and the filing of certified copies as directed in Section 3.
