ORDINANCE NO. 1033

EXTENDING THE CORPORATE LIMITS OF THE CITY OF AUSTIN TO THE
EDDIE.

WHEREAS, the owners of the property hereinafter
described, Lawrence E. Lyons and Kenneth H. Lyons, filed a
Petition requesting the annexation of the territory
hereinafter described which was duly presented to the Council,

AND WHEREAS, the quantity of land embraced within the
area described in the Petition and bounded as described is
less than 200 acres of unplatted land, no part of which is
included within the limits of an incorporated city, village,
or borough

AND WHEREAS, the Petition was signed by all the owners,

AND WHEREAS, no objections to annexation have been
received from the Town Board, the County Board, or the
governing body of any municipality whose boundaries abut upon
the boundaries of the land to be annexed,

AND WHEREAS, the land described in the Petition abuts
the City of Austin on the northern boundary thereof:

NOW THEREFORE THE COMMON COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF
AUSTIN, MINNESOTA DO ORDAIN,

SECTION 1: The City Council hereby determines that
the annexation shall be to the best interests of the City and
of the territory affected; that the territory described herein
abuts the City limits and is urban or suburban in character;
and that none of said territory is now included within the
limits of any city, village or borough.

SECTION 2. The corporate limits of the City are
hereby extended to include the unplatted land as follows,
and the same is hereby annexed to and included within the
City as effectually as if it had originally been a part thereof:

Commencing at the Southwest Corner of the
Northwest quarter of the Southeast quarter of
Section 34, Township 103 North, Range 18 West;
thence East 633.0 feet on the North line of
Durr Oak Park Addition in said section, to the
Northeast Corner of said addition; thence East
562.7 feet on the North line of Down Town Plaza
Shopping Center Rearranged Plot in said section,
which point shall hereinafter be called the point
of beginning; thence Northeastly 169.0 feet
at a deflection angle of $56^{\circ}19'$ left; thence
Northeastly 213.8 feet at a deflection angle of
 $6^{\circ}30'$ left; thence Northwesterly 623 feet more or less
at a deflection angle of $26^{\circ}15'$ left, to the
Southernly right-of-way line of Interstate Highway
No. 90; thence 447.6 feet Easterly along said

Highway right-of-way line to the West line of Lot 6, Block 2 of Barbara Addition in said section; thence Southerly 53.0 feet to the Southeast Corner of said Lot 6; thence Easterly 95.6 feet on the South line of said Lot 6, to the Westerly right-of-way line of 3rd Street N.E.; thence Southwesterly 135.78 feet at a deflection angle of $66^{\circ}00'$ right on the Westerly right-of-way line of 3rd Street N.E.; thence Southerly 133.81 feet on a curve to the right, with a radius of 156.47 feet, and through a central angle of $49^{\circ}50'$, to the end point of said curve; thence Southwesterly 6.3 feet, on the tangent to said curve at said end point; thence Southerly 47.23 feet on a curve to the left, with a radius of 256.43 feet and through a central angle of $18^{\circ}32'$, to the end point of said curve, on the Westerly right-of-way line of 3rd Street N.E.; thence Easterly 130.3 feet on an extension of the North line of 14th Avenue N.E. in the Herman Sandler Addition, in Section 24, Township 103 North, Range 10 West; thence Southerly 310.25 feet at a deflection angle of $90^{\circ}19'$ left; thence Easterly 58.0 feet at a deflection angle of $89^{\circ}41'$ left; thence Southerly 104.75 feet at a deflection angle of $89^{\circ}41'$ right; thence Easterly 64.9 feet at a deflection angle of $89^{\circ}41'$ left; thence Southerly 319.0 feet at a deflection angle of $89^{\circ}41'$ right; thence Easterly 58.7 feet at a deflection angle of $89^{\circ}41'$ left; thence Southerly 66.3 feet at a deflection angle of $89^{\circ}41'$ right, to the North line of Down Town Plaza Shopping Center Rearranged Plat in Section 24, Township 103 North, Range 10 West; thence Easterly 830.75 feet, on the North line of Down Town Plaza Shopping Center Rearranged Plat in said section, to the point of beginning.

SECTION 3. The City Recorder is hereby directed to file certified copies of this Ordinance with the Minnesota Municipal Commission, the Secretary of State and the County Auditor.

SECTION 4. This Ordinance takes effect on its passage and publishing and the filing of the certified copies as directed in Section 3.
