ORDINANCE NO. 1034

GENERAL AND CORPORATE LIMITS OF THE CITY OF AUSTIN TO THE WEST

WHEREAS, the owners of the property hereinbefore described, the Independent School District No. 605, N. A. Schraefel and Anna H. Schraefel, filed a Petition requesting the annexation of the territory herinafter described which was duly presented to the Council;

AND WHEREAS, the quantity of land embraced within the area described in the Petition and bounded as described is less than 200 acres of platted land, no part of which is included within the limits of an incorporated city, village, or borough;

AND WHEREAS, the Petition was signed by all the owners;

AND WHEREAS, no objections to annexation have been received from the Town Board, the County Board, or the governing body of any municipality whose boundaries abut upon the boundaries of the land to be annexed;

AND WHEREAS, the land described in the Petition abuts the City of Austin on the western boundary thereof;

NOW THEREFORE THE COMMON COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF AUSTIN, MINNESOTA DO ORDEA,

SECTION 1. The City Council hereby determines that the annexation shall be to the best interests of the City and of the territory affected; that the territory described herein abuts the City limits and is urban or suburban in character; and that none of said territory is now included within the limits of any city, village or borough.

SECTION 2. The corporate limits of the City are hereby extended to include the platted land as follows, and the same is hereby annexed to and included within the City as effectually as if it had originally been a part thereof:

Those parts of the Southeast Quarter of Section 33, Township 103 North, Range 18 West, Stearns County, Minnesota, described below as Tracts I, II and III except that part of said Tracts II and III heretofore annexed to the corporate limits of said city by Ordinances No. 360 and No. 364, to-wit:

Tract I: The West Half of said quarter section except the part thereof lying North of the land taken by condemnation as Parcel No. 13 in the final certificate recorded in Book 17 of Miscellaneous, Page 413, and described as Parcel 213 in the notice of sale pending recorded in Book 9 of Miscellaneous, Page 583.

Section II: The Northeast quarter of said quarter section except the first 16 acres of said Northeast quarter.

Section III: The first 16 acres of the Southeast quarter of said quarter section.

SECTION 3. The City Recorder is hereby directed to file certified copies of this Ordinance with the Minnesota Municipal Commission, the Secretary of State and the County Auditor.

SECTION 4. This Ordinance takes effect on its passage and publishing and the filing of the certified copies as directed in Section 3.
