WHEREAS, litter in our scenic areas is a discredit to our state, costly to the citizen, a health menace and fire hazard, and constitutes a year-around problem which represents an individual responsibility, and

WHEREAS, it is, indeed, a challenge to citizenship to undertake a statewide clean-up campaign in the Fall to avoid a littered landscape when Spring arrives,


NOW, THEREFORE, I, Karl F. Rolvaag, Governor of the State of Minnesota, do hereby proclaim the week of October 24 through October 30 as


