

PROCLAMATION

WHEREAS, the mental, physical, social and spiritual welfare of our children provide the basis upon which we build for the future; and

WHEREAS, parents and teachers need to cooperate to provide the opportunity for every child to develop to his fullest capacity in order to create the best foundation for citizenship; and

WHEREAS, the Minnesota Congress of Parents and Teachers with nearly one-quarter million memberships, an organization which cares about the homes in which children live, the schools in which they are taught, and the neighborhoods in which they grow up, is pledged to promote the welfare of children and youth; and

WHEREAS, the month of October is designated as membership enrollment month;

NOW, THEREFORE, I, Karl F. Rolvaag, Governor of the State of Minnesota, do proclaim the month of October, 1965 as

"PTA MEMBERSHIP ENROLLMENT MONTH"

in the State of Minnesota and urge all citizens of Minnesota to give attention to the importance of cooperation in promoting the welfare of children and youth through the objects of the Parent Teacher Association, and to join the local PTA.
