

PROCLAMATION

WHEREAS, the day of Monday, October 4, 1965 is being observed nationally as Child Health Day, and

WHEREAS, Child Health Day is an appropriate time to consider methods of improving child health and safety, and

WHEREAS, more deaths and disabilities in children are caused by accidents than from the six leading causes of death from disease, and

WHEREAS, individuals living in a safe environment with safe habits and attitudes and safe equipment can avoid accidental injury to themselves and to others,

NOW, THEREFORE, I, Karl F. Rolvaag, Governor of the State of Minnesota, do hereby proclaim October 4, 1965 as

"CHILD HEALTH DAY"

In Minnesota, and I encourage and commend all agencies, organizations, and individuals to eliminate existing or potential accident hazards in the home, the farm, the school, or the highway and to instill safe attitudes and habits in order that children may be forewarned and safeguarded and may be able to grow up to become the adults of tomorrow.

IN WITNESS WHEREOF, I have hereunto set my hand and caused the Great Seal of the State of Minnesota to be affixed at the State Capitol this sixteenth day of September in the year of our Lord one thousand nine hundred and sixty-five and of the state, the one hundred eighth.
