ORDINANCE NO. 104

AN ORDINANCE EXTENDING THE CORPORATE LIMITS
OF THE CITY OF STAPLES AND INCORPORATING
ADDITIONAL TERRITORY THEREIN

The City Council of the City of Staples do ordain as follows:

SECTION 1. A petition has been filed with the governing body of the City of Staples, Minnesota by all the owners of the following described real estate to have such land included within the City of Staples, Minnesota:

Commencing at a point 266 feet North of the Northeast corner of Lot Four (4) of Block Three (3) of Brannon Addition to Staples, thence north 50 feet on and along the west line of Third Street; thence West 300 feet; thence south 50 feet; thence east 300 feet to the point of beginning, all in and with the Northwest Quarter of the Southwest Quarter (NW $\frac{1}{4}$ of SW $\frac{1}{4}$) of Section One (1) in Township One Hundred Thirty-three (133) North of Range Thirty-three (33) West, said tract containing less than 200 acres.

SECTION 2. The City Council hereby determines that the annexation will be to the best interests of the City of Staples, Minnesota and of the territory affected; that the territory described herein abuts upon the City and is so conditioned as properly to be subjected to City government.

SECTION 3. Therefore, the City of Staples, Minnesota hereby ordains and declares that the property hereinbefore described by and the same is hereby annexed to, and included in, the City of Staples, Minnesota as effectually as if it had originally been a part thereof.
