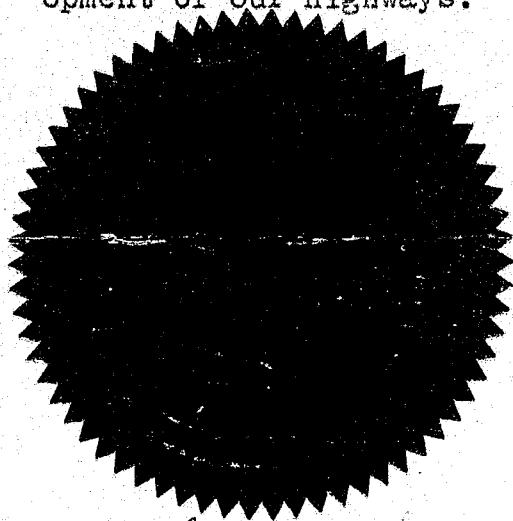

TUESDAY, JUNE 19, 1917,
